

# Celebration 2010

150th Anniversary of the Mennonite Brethren

Mennonite Brethren around the globe begin celebrating their 150th Anniversary on January 6, 2010. National celebrations will take place in India, Panama, Brazil, Japan, and Paraguay, as well as in Germany, which will host International Community of Mennonite Brethren (ICOMB) meetings and celebrations.

North America will host Celebration 2010: the 150th Anniversary of the Mennonite Brethren, on July 12-18, 2010 in British Columbia, the world stage for the 2010 Vancouver Olympic Games.

Opening that event will be “Renewing Identity & Mission: a Mennonite Brethren Consultation.” During this time Mennonite Brethren will explore where they have been, where they are going, and what they have learnt along the way.

North Langley Community Church will host Gathering 2010 and Gracepoint Community Church will host the USMB Convention (the biennial conventions of the U.S. and Canadian conferences). Celebration services, and bi-national and international business sessions, will take place at the Chandos Pattison Auditorium located on the campus of Pacific Academy in Surrey. Together we will magnify Jesus in whom “we live” by celebrating who we are and whose we are.
